Session 4- Episode Introduction: The Rock on Which It is Built

Jesus is calling for change of heart. What He asks is for radical inward transformation. For our headstrong fisherman Simon, his life and family under threat from Rome, Simon spends one last night fishing in a desperate attempt to square his debts and things seem as if they could not get worse. Bu then Simon encounters Jesus and something he never expected and therefore the start of transformation.

- 1. What is your perception of how Simon (Peter) is being portrayed in this series so far?

- 3. What stands out to you regarding the backstories of the apostles so far? Any additional allusions or allegories in this episode?

Faith Reflection

- 1. Do you believe God allows adverse circumstances to draw you back in to Him?
- 2. Do you believe miracles happen in modern times? When miracles happen what part did God play and what part do believers play?
- 3. When you have gotten yourself (and / or family) into a desperate situation from not following Christ's ways, do you tend to eventually seek Him for a miracle or do you feel you must "fix" things first? Can you share a story?
- 4. Have you ever cried out to God in anger because you were not seeing His help? Do you think it is "ok" to express your anger and disappointment to God? How do you imagine God responds?
